COVID19 - CHILDLINE 1098 Emergency Response: Mizoram

In Mizoram, CHILDLINE organized several initiatives to help the children and their families in need. The local district administration has been a strong pillar of support for CHILDLINE during relief activities in all districts of Mizoram.

- CHILDLINE Lunglei created an audio visual documentary on the protection of children during lock down which was broadcasted on TV as well as on radio channels across the state.
- In Mizoram, a total of 150 school children received face masks and hand soap from CHILDLINE Aizawl and four children were provided with nutritional support.
- Baptist Church Orphanage received donation of INR 4000 from CHILDLINE Lunglei. The team also conducted an outreach programme at Baptist Church Orphanage and visited often to supervise them during the lockdown.
- CHILDLINE Lunglei and Aizawal distributed pamphlets to spread awareness on the preventive measures of Covid-19, child Rights and children safety.



CHILDLINE provides nutritional support to a 7-year old and her father

While conducting an outreach activity during the lockdown, CHILDLINE Aizawl, Mizoram came across the case of 7-year old child in need of nutritional support. The child's parents were separated and she was living with her father. The father was 65-years old and was suffering from chronic asthma and joint pains, due to which he was unable to get stable work. Local people often helped him with cash or kind. The neighbours would engage him in less laborious tasks that would help him earn some money for his daughter. Due to the pandemic, the father could not do any work. Upon receiving this information CHILDLINE provided adequate nutritional support to the family. They were overwhelmed by the response and thanked CHILDLINE for their support.
